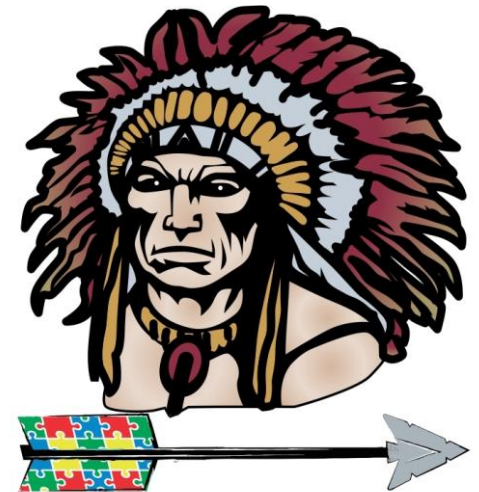

What Grades Compete?

We may license any School Teacher for grades 3-12 for co-ed competitive archery teams. The National Archery in The Schools Program and Scholastic 3D Archery both have active teams currently competing in Illinois and Wisconsin.

How much does Archery cost?

School Archery Program Equipment costs between \$3,000 and \$5,000. However, many schools pay little or no money for a program! There are huge sponsors for School Archery, and Hononegah Archery will help connect you with the right people.

Teacher Licensing

School Teacher Archery Licensing is a one-time 8-hour Saturday class. We prefer to get 5 teachers or parents who will be active in the program together for a class. Cost is \$150 per archery instructor.

Archery Gym Unit

If you want to try out Archery for a gym unit, we can bring our Mobile Archery Range and equipment to your school! Classes may be held outside, or in your Gymnasium with our 10’ x 30’ Archery Safety Net. Cost is determined by participation, but usually \$20 per student for a 2 or 3 hour archery gym unit.

Students with different abilities

For special needs students, an Archery Team may be the only time they ever get to compete in a sport alongside their mainstream peers! Archery is a new opportunity for a student with a physical or mental disability to earn their Athletic Letter or College Scholarship money!
